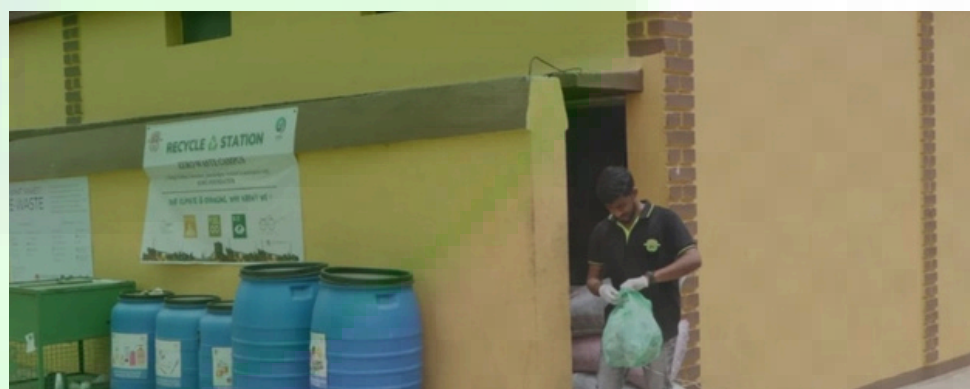
PROJECT MISSION LIFE

Mentor of KORU Foundation. Along with him, joined Mrs. CH Madhuri, Educationist and Guinness World record holder and Mr. Dipak Kumar soni, Project coordinator KORU Foundation, Solid waste Expert. The speakers engaged in discussion regarding the theme of upcoming *World Environment Day* that centres around *"Beat the Plastic"* and had an Interactive and informative session exchanging ideas with the University students over the issue of Climate Change and Waste Management. The key focus was on recycling of plastic products.



PROJECT PLANTATION DRIVE

NSS Cell of NSU organised the fourth activity namely "PLANTATION DRIVE" in collaboration with the B.ed department under the project of MISSION LIFE today. In this campaign, the students coming for their orientation brought saplings with stickers of their names and planted them in the campus with the assigned responsibility of those saplings. Almost 100 saplings like Mango, Guava, Pomegranate, Lemon, Peepal, Banana, Neem were planted by the faculties and the students.

The younger brother of the martyr appreciated this noble effort of the university and also appealed that we all should respect the soldiers around us.
