Some of these complications include hypoglycemia, the development of insulin resistance, severe cardiovascular risks, and risks associated with cancer. In light of this, the quest for efficacious anti-diabetic medicines derived from natural sources provides an attractive possibility for the creation of new categories of therapies. Both traditional medicine and a number of different experimental research point to the fact that edible and medicinal mushrooms have a significant amount of therapeutic potential when it comes to the treatment of diabetes. In today world, isolating and identifying particular bioactive chemicals that possess antidiabetic qualities as well as elucidating the processes behind their hypoglicemic activity is becoming an increasingly significant task. An extensive number of polysaccharides and triterpenes have been isolated from a diverse range of mushroom species, and the structural characteristics of these compounds as well as the methods by which

oyster mushroom can be explained by the enhanced phosphorylation of AMPK and the elevated levels of mRNA in muscle and adipose tissues. Therefore, the anti-diabetic action of oyster mushrooms may be related to the inhibitor activity of the hydrolysable enzymes, which slows down the digestion of carbohydrates and, as a result, delays the rise in blood glucose levels.

Ethical Considerations and Compliance

The committee discussed the following ethical aspects of the experiment:

- Justification for Animal Use: The researcher provided justification for the necessity of using animals and the lack of suitable alternatives.
- Animal Welfare and Care: The proposal outlined housing conditions, feeding, and veterinary care.
- Pain Management and Humane Treatment: The protocol included methods for minimizing distress, anesthesia use, and euthanasia procedures.
- Compliance with Regulations: The study was assessed for adherence to Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee.

* Strengths of the Proposal: The foundation of this work is the use of herbal items to treat diabetes.
