### C. Amendment in existing ordinance / Scheme / Syllabus.

1. The Board of Studies recommended to start a new course i.e. **B.A (Honours.) in Journalism and Mass communication** the Board of Studies considered the modification regarding the scheme change of the **B.A (Honours.) in Journalism and Mass communication** examination. The Board of Studies recommended that it should comprise of 100 marks and the scheme of Internal Marks will be decided by Department of Journalism and Mass Communication which shall be divided into Unit Test, Assignments and Presentations, and Attendance.

**Examinations evaluation pattern for B.A (Honours.) in Journalism and Mass communication each course will carry 100 marks and will have two components:**

#### I. Internal Assessment 30 marks.

- a. Written Examination: 15 marks
- b. Assignments and Presentations, and Attendance: 15

marks

#### II. End-Semester Examination 70 marks.

2. The Board of Studies considered that grading system in Assignments and Presentations, and Attendance should be implemented and same should be informed to the examination controller.
3. The Programme Outcomes (POs), Programme Specific Outcomes (PSOs) and Course Outcomes (COs) have been included in the syllabus.
