Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme for Economically Weaker Section (EWS)

This policy document outlines the official framework for the **Fee Waiver Scheme for the Economically Weaker Section (EWS)** at **Netaji Subhas University (NSU)**, Jamshedpur. The university is committed to ensuring that financial barriers do not prevent deserving students from pursuing higher education.

1. Policy Objective

The primary objective of the EWS Fee Waiver Scheme is to provide financial relief and academic support to talented students from low-income families. By offering need-based aid, NSU aims to promote educational equity and social inclusion within the Jamshedpur region.

2. Scope of Financial Assistance

The benefits under this scheme vary based on the student's overall financial profile and academic standing:

- **Need-Based Aid:** Students with family annual income below **₹3 lakh** are eligible for Tuition fee waived off up to 20% discount in tuition fees **annually**.
- **Tuition Fee Waiver:** Depending on the specific program and session, the university may provide significant waivers for those who demonstrate exceptional financial need alongside academic merit.

3. Eligibility Criteria

To qualify for the EWS Fee Waiver Scheme, a candidate must meet the following requirements:

- **Family Income:** The combined annual income of the applicant's parents or guardians from all sources must be below the university's prescribed threshold, generally **₹3 lakh per annum**.
- **Academic Qualification:**
 - **Undergraduate (UG):** Candidates must meet the minimum marks in their 10+2 examinations (typically **45% to 50%** depending on the course).
 - **Postgraduate (PG):** Candidates must hold a relevant bachelor's degree with the required aggregate percentage for their chosen program.
- **Enrolment Status:** The candidate must be a regular, full-time student admitted into a PG/UG/Diploma program at NSU Jamshedpur.
- **Citizenship:** The scholarship is generally open only to **Indian nationals**.





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4. Terms and Conditions for Renewal

To continue receiving the fee waiver in subsequent semesters or years, students must adhere to the following:

- **Attendance:** A minimum of **75% attendance** is mandatory in every semester.
- **Academic Progress:** Students must maintain a satisfactory **Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA)** and clear all examinations in the first attempt.
- **Conduct:** Recipients must strictly follow the university's code of conduct; any disciplinary action may lead to the immediate withdrawal of financial aid.

5. Required Documentation

Applicants must submit the following documents to the Admissions Office for verification:

1. **Income Certificate:** A valid income certificate issued by a competent authority within the current financial year.
2. **Academic Records:** Copies of 10th and 12th-grade mark sheets and graduation degree (for PG applicants).
3. **Identity Proof:** Copy of Aadhaar Card and recent passport-sized photographs.

6. Application Process

- **Submission:** Applications are usually invited during the **admission process** or at the start of the academic session.
- **Verification:** The University Scholarship Committee reviews the submitted financial documents and academic records.
- **Approval:** Final approval is granted by the Registrar or the University Board of Management based on the committee's recommendations.

Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme for Students Belongs to Rural Areas

The **Fee Waiver Scheme** for at Netaji Subhas University (NSU), Jamshedpur, is designed to enhance access to higher education for students from underserved rural backgrounds in Jharkhand and across India. This policy aims to ensure that geographical and economic barriers do not prevent talented students from pursuing professional and academic excellence.

1. Policy Objective

The primary goal is to provide financial incentives to students residing in rural areas, encouraging their participation in higher education and professional training. By offering fee waivers, NSU Jamshedpur supports socio-economic development within local rural communities.

2. Scope and Benefits

Eligible students may receive financial assistance based on their specific rural background and economic status:

- **Tuition Fee Waiver:** A reduction of **20%** in tuition fees, depending on the combined merit and income verification.
- **Hostel Assistance:** Students Belongs to Rural Areas may apply for need-based aid toward hostel and mess charges.

3. Eligibility Criteria

To qualify for the Rural Area Fee Waiver, applicants must meet the following conditions:

- **Rural Status:** The applicant must be a permanent resident of a village or rural area as classified by the Census of India or relevant state government authorities.
- **Income Threshold:** The total annual family income from all sources must generally not exceed **₹3.0 Lakh** to qualify for maximum assistance.
- **Academic Standing:**
 - **Undergraduate (UG):** Candidates must have secured at least **60% marks** in their Class 12 (Intermediate) examination.
 - **Postgraduate (PG):** Candidates must have passed their graduation with a minimum of **50% marks**.
- **Admission Mode:** The student must be enrolled in a **regular, full-time program**.





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4. Required Documentation

Applicants are required to submit a verified "Rural Category Dossier" to the NSU Finance Cell:

1. **Rural Domicile Certificate:** An official certificate or residence proof issued by a competent authority certifying rural residency.
2. **Income Certificate:** A valid income certificate issued within the current financial year.
3. **Educational Mark Sheets:** Mark sheets of the qualifying 10th and 12th-grade examinations.
4. **Bonafide Certificate:** Provided by the university confirming current enrolment.

5. Maintenance and Renewal

To continue receiving the fee waiver in subsequent semesters/years, the student must:

- Maintain a minimum **CGPA** of 6.0 (or as prescribed for specific courses).
- Ensure a minimum of **75% attendance** in every semester.
- Maintain a clean disciplinary record with no university-level sanctions.

6. Application Process

- **Inquiry:** Candidates should check for active scholarship windows at the **NSU Admissions Office**.
- **Form Submission:** Complete the "Financial Aid / Rural Waiver Application" form during the admission process.
- **Verification:** The University Scholarship Committee will conduct a physical or telephonic verification of the rural residence and income status before final approval.

Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme for Single Girl Child

This policy document outlines the official framework for the **Single Girl Child Fee Waiver (SGCFW) Scheme** at Netaji Subhas University (NSU), Jamshedpur. It is designed to promote higher education among women and support families in the Jamshedpur region who are dedicated to the academic advancement of their only daughter.

1. Policy Objective

The primary objective of this scheme is to provide financial incentives to the "Single Girl Child" to ensure that financial constraints do not hinder her pursuit of professional and higher education. NSU aims to recognize the value of the girl child and encourage her participation in diverse academic fields.

2. Scope of the Waiver

The benefit package under this scheme is structured as follows:

- **Tuition Fee Relaxation:** A base relaxation of **20%** is applied to the standard tuition fees.
- **Applicability:** This waiver applies to all full-time undergraduate and postgraduate programs offered by the university.

3. Eligibility Criteria

To be considered for the SGCFW Scheme, a candidate must fulfil all the following requirements:

- **Family Composition:** The applicant must be the **only child** of her parents. She must have no brothers or sisters (biological or adopted).
- **Exclusion for Twins:** If there are twin daughters or fraternal daughters, both are considered eligible under this specific university scheme.
- **Enrolment Status:** The candidate must have secured admission into a regular, full-time degree program at NSU Jamshedpur for the current academic session.
- **Age Limitation:** For those applying to Postgraduate (PG) programs, the applicant should not exceed **30 years of age** at the time of admission.





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4. Terms and Conditions for Maintenance

The continuation of the fee waiver in subsequent academic years is contingent upon the student's performance and conduct:

- **Academic Standing:** The student must maintain a satisfactory **CGPA** as defined by the university's academic council.
- **Attendance Requirement:** A minimum of **75% attendance** is mandatory in every semester to remain eligible for the waiver.
- **Disciplinary Record:** The student must not have any record of misconduct or disciplinary action taken against them by the university.

5. Required Documentation

Applicants must submit a verified "Single Girl Child" dossier to the Admissions Office, including:

1. **Family Proof:** A certificate of family composition issued by a competent Revenue Officer (e.g., Tehsildar or BDO).
2. **Academic Credentials:** Self-attested copies of 10th and 12th-grade mark sheets.
3. **Identification:** Copy of Aadhaar Card and a recent passport-sized photograph.

6. Application Procedure

- **Step 1:** Submit the application during the admission process or within 15 days of the start of the academic session.
- **Step 2:** The University Verification Committee will review the documents and provide a recommendation to the Registrar for final approval.

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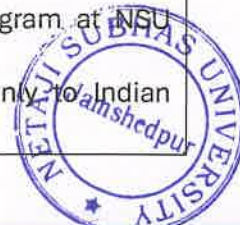
